

16. The Pool Manager or Assistant Manager may close the pool at any time due to personal discretion, operational difficulties and inclement weather.

17. Patrons will deposit all debris in the trash cans in the pool area.

18. Please have ALL members of your family (or any guests) read the rules and regulations of the pool. Parents are responsible for the behavior of their children. Members are responsible for the behavior of their guests.

19. Patrons may use the pool chairs for sitting only; tipping, rocking, or using the chairs for other than their intended purpose is prohibited. Patrons are responsible for property damage they cause due to willful misuse.

20. The Association is not responsible for lost or damaged personal property. The pool staff will hold "found" articles for two weeks before disposing.

21. Patrons will park bicycles in the bicycle rack. Do not park bicycles in front of the pool entrance or on the sidewalk.

22. Smoking is STRICTLY PROHIBITED in the pool area. Anyone wishing to smoke must do so away from the front gate. If smoking, please extinguish your cigarette butts in BUTT BUCKET provided.

23. Patrons will not use profanity or abusive language in the pool area.

GUEST POLICY

1. All pool guests must be accompanied by a pool member and must sign in at the gate. Guests under 8 years old must be accompanied by an adult member at all times.

2. No permanent resident of Elizabeth Lake can be a guest.

3. For out of town guests, there will be no guest charge.

4. For guests residing in Hampton, there will be a \$4.00 per day guest fee.

Membership Opportunities:

Family membership: All members of a family residing in single residence, unlimited use of the pool during operating hours.

Individual Membership: One person membership, unlimited use of the pool during operating hours. No one under 18 years of age. Not available to swim team families.

Weekender Family: For the family that works! Unlimited use of the pool during operating hours from 5 pm on Friday through Sunday. There is no weekender individuals. Not available to swim team families.

Grandparents: \$30/ week for those grandparents who have grandchildren coming from out of town but do not wish a summer membership. Unlimited use of the pool during operating hours for that week.

Senior Couple: Those couples who have one member over the age of 70 and reside in the same residence, unlimited use of the pool during operating hours.

Tideriders Swim Team

The Tideriders swim team is Elizabeth Lake swim team for children ages 4-18 years of age. They have a very long history in the community and have won their Division title many times. It is a wonderful way to enhance the swim experience, meet other children their age and have fun! The team has 3-4 home meets every year. On those evenings the pool will close at 4 pm. These dates will be posted on the Swimming pool calendar, available May 15th, as well as at the pool starting the day prior to the meet. The date of the annual swim team awards banquet will be posted in advance also. Please come and cheer our wonderful team at the meets.

POOL SAFETY RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules have been established for the benefit and protection of all users of the pool. These will help ensure safe and sanitary operation of the pool facilities and provide enjoyable recreation for all members and their guests. Parents (members) should instruct their children and or guests to observe these rules and to obey the instructions of the Pool Manager, Assistant Manager and the Lifeguards. The following disciplinary procedures are in effect for failure to comply with the pool rules:

First Offense..... Warning

Second Offense..... One-Day Suspension

Third Offense.....One Week Suspension (pool ID will be held)

In the case of a minor being suspended, parents will be notified of offense and ensuing consequences. Enforcement of these rules is the responsibility of the on duty pool manager.

All pool patrons must have a pool membership card with them at the pool. Pictures will be taken the first time a patron is at the pool and the card will be available within 72 hours. The pool patron may still use the pool until the card is available. Replacement cards are \$10 apiece.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Patrons under **8 years old are not permitted in the main pool unless accompanied by a person 13 years or older and must demonstrate a minimum swim proficiency.** Minimum proficiency is the ability to swim, unassisted, one length of the pool. Children not able to pass the swimming proficiency test will not be allowed to use the slide or diving board. Parents are responsible for a child who is unable to swim. At **NO** time is a child under 8 to be left unattended .

2. The state health department requires mandatory closing for 8 hours (recycling time) when feces are present in the pool. (Swim diapers may be purchased from Life Guards or the concession stand.)

3. Persons with infectious, open, or bandaged sores may not use the pool. Children in diapers must wear swim diapers (disposable diapers are prohibited as these disintegrate and do not allow adequate protection from "accidents".

4. Spouting of water and similar unhygienic actions are not permitted.

5. All glass containers are FORBIDDEN in the pool area.

6. Patrons are requested to shower before entering the pool.

7. The wading pool is not under lifeguard supervision; parents or someone 13 years or older must supervise children using the wading pool. Children may have safe water toys in the wading pool, subject to approval by the Pool Manager or Assistant Manager. In general, children over 6 years old may not use the wading pool.

8. **RUNNING IN THE POOL AREA IS PROHIBITED.**

9. Horseplay in the pool is prohibited. Handball (wall ball) is NOT allowed to be played against the sides of the pool house or pump house.

10. Patrons may not climb on the fence or the structures in the pool area (including the roof).

11. Backward dives or flips off the wall are prohibited. No more than one person is allowed on the board at one time. Divers may bounce on the board one time before diving. Diving and jumping from the side of the board is not permitted. There will be no ball playing from the diving board.

12. No more than one person will be permitted on the slide at one time. There will be no reaching down to anyone once you are on the slide.

13. Swimming in the diving area is prohibited unless it is a part of authorized use when the board is not in use.

14. Styrofoam floats, air mattresses, etc. are not permitted in the pool. Guide lines for "noodle" use will be dependent on the number of patrons utilizing the pool. Patrons may wear swim goggles and use nerf-type balls with the permission of the Pool Mgr or Assistant Manager. Snorkeling is not permitted, except during adult swim.

15. The pool will be cleared for 15 minutes at 45 minutes after the hour to permit adult swimming. Patrons must be 17 years old to use the pool during these periods. Adults may have one non-swimmer in the pool with them for the purpose of instruction with pool manager approval.
